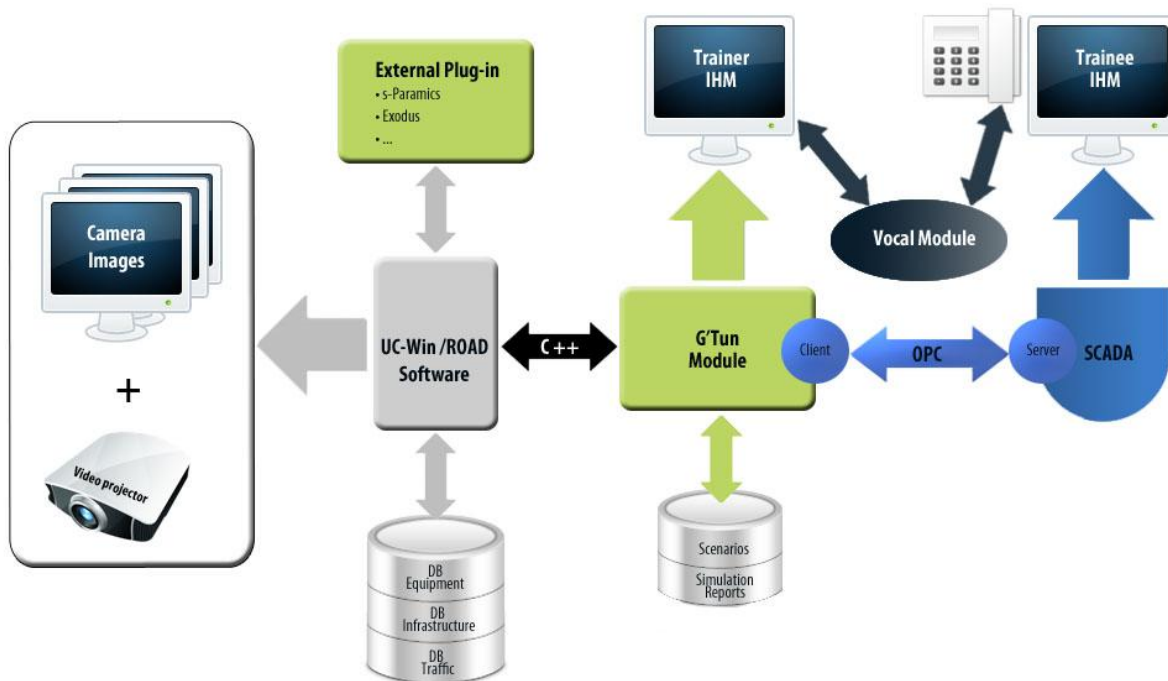

FORUM8 & BMIA wins Safety Initiative of the Year Award at the International Tunnelling Awards!

FORUM8 and BMIA received the prize for Safety Initiative of the Year at the NCE International Tunnelling Awards ceremony carried out in Hong Kong on the 1st of December 2011 for their jointly-developed Tunnel Management and Operator Training System, G'VAL.

Using G'VAL, the trainer can trigger various incidents which are visually simulated using FORUM8's UC-win/Road (aka VR-Design Studio). The trainees respond to these incidents accordingly and the trainer can review the actions taken by the trainees and advise on areas to be improved and so on.



UC-win/Road's real-time software enables the user to make any 3D environment (tunnels, bridges, highways etc.) easily and quickly, so that you can use real or proposed tunnels, bridges or highways to train operators in G'VAL.

Also, environments created in UC-win/Road can be used for stakeholder consultation (e.g. to be shown to decision makers so that they can understand the benefits of your proposed projects visually and interactively), design validation and research.
